ANSWERS FROM TEDDY THE TAX MAN

Q: Teddy The Tax Man, I have one word of praise and one word of criticism for you. Thank you for rolling over my 401k to the IRA so quickly. It took approximately 9 days fewer than I thought it would. My criticism is that you didn't put my husband's name on the IRA. What do I need to do to correct it? Can I do it myself?

A: Thanks for the word of praise! Everyone likes to get that pat on the back every once in a while. Regarding changing the IRA, you cannot have a joint IRA. I-R-A stands for Individual Retirement Arrangement, with the emphasis on INDIVIDUAL. You did name him as the beneficiary, so the objectives you tried to meet, you met.

Q: I noticed that when my 401k was still with my employer, and I requested a distribution, twenty percent would be withheld for federal taxes. After I rolled it into an IRA, I was told that I could have however much I wanted withheld. I could even tell them NOT to withhold ANYTHING! Why didn't someone tell me about this earlier? I love being in control of my own money!

A: If you plan well, it's a beautiful thing, isn't it? Just make sure that your advisor is a part of your decision making, so that your taxes at the end of the year will work well for you and your household.

Q: As of September 2015, I am now divorced. The divorce decree says that my former spouse and I are responsible for our 2014 tax liability 50/50. How in the world does this work? We are not even on speaking terms.

A: Unfortunately, the two of you absolutely MUST work something out. The IRS does not care whether you pay 80 percent and the former spouse pays 20 percent or vice versa. They just want to be paid. If they are not paid, they'll pounce on both of you.
